

POST TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS

1. It is normal to experience some post-operative discomfort after a root canal is completed. This discomfort should subside within a few days. The sensitivity can be managed by medications such as Advil (ibuprofen) or Tylenol (acetaminophen). If these medications do not control the discomfort please contact the office.
2. Please return to your family dentist for the final restoration of the treated tooth within six weeks. While waiting to see your dentist, avoid chewing on the tooth. If the temporary filling falls out, it must be replaced immediately to prevent reinfection.
3. A follow-up x-ray to evaluate healing should be taken after one year. Your family dentist or our office can take this x-ray, whichever is convenient.

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
